## TANI TELAS (Stéphanie Navarro) stands at the forefront of progressive abstraction,



weaving a narrative deeply embedded in her Corsican, French, and Spanish heritage.

Her work is a dialogue with the **Mediterranean**—a vibrant, constant source that dictates the rhythm of her practice.

**Tani Telas' process** is a deliberate journey toward formal liberation. It commences in the quietude of color calibration—an emotional mapping that precedes the act of painting. This interiority then erupts into visceral movement, where instinct takes command of the canvas.

The final resolution is an integration of the Mediterranean's geological and ancestral soul, resulting in an abstract vocabulary that resonates with both **raw emotion and cultural depth**.

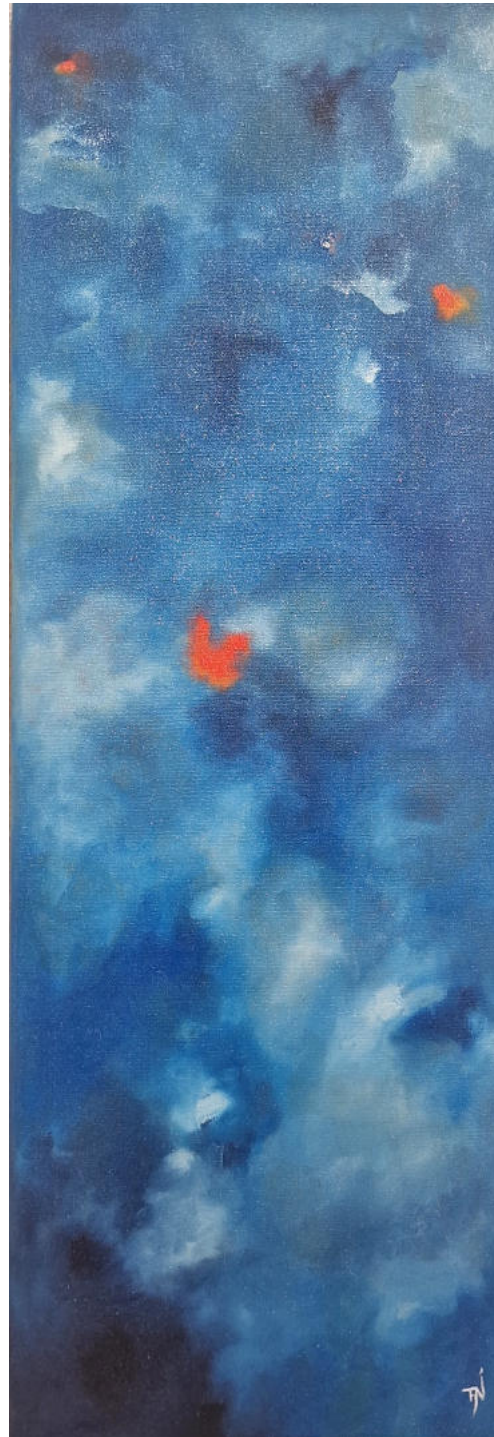

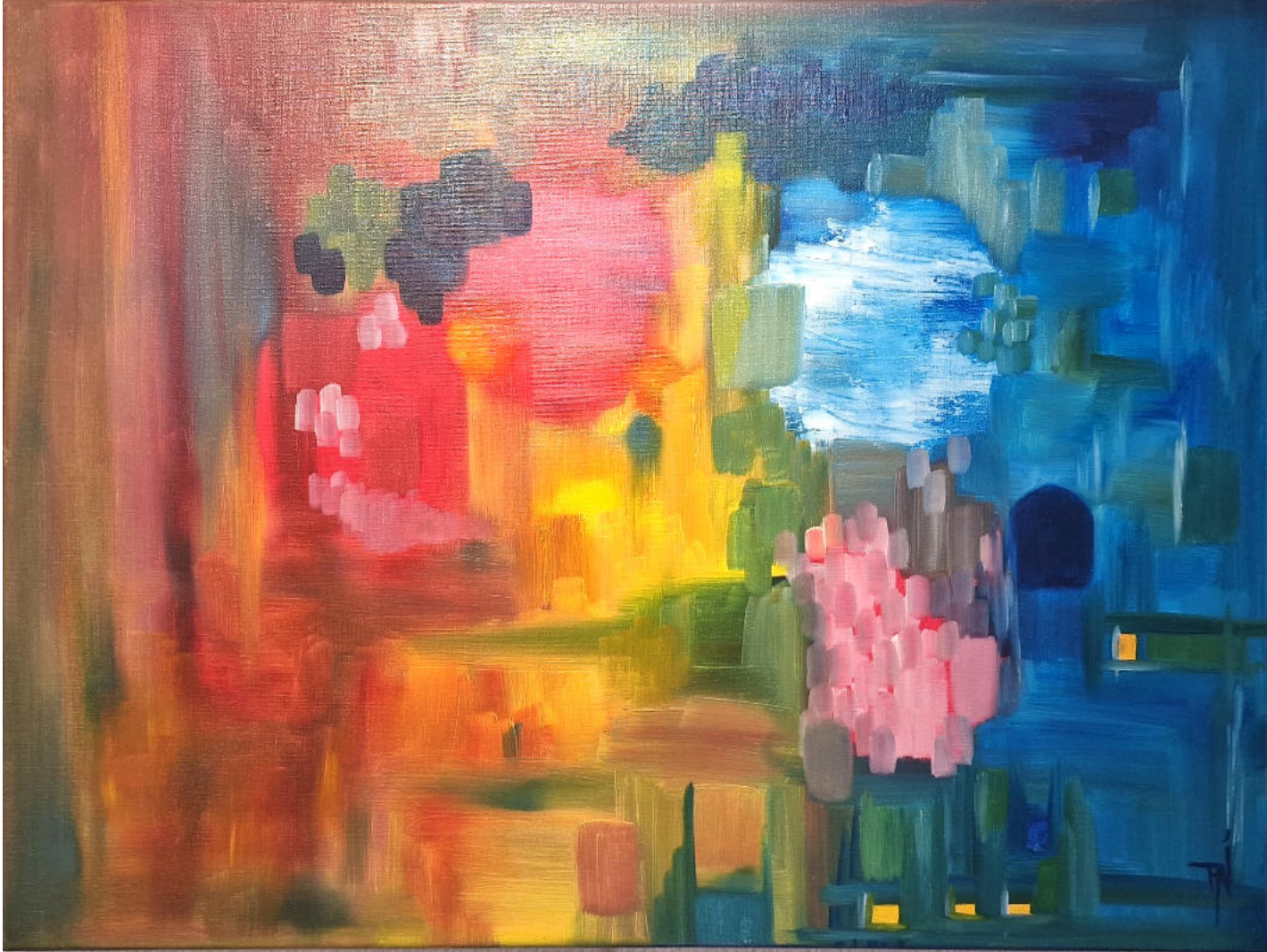

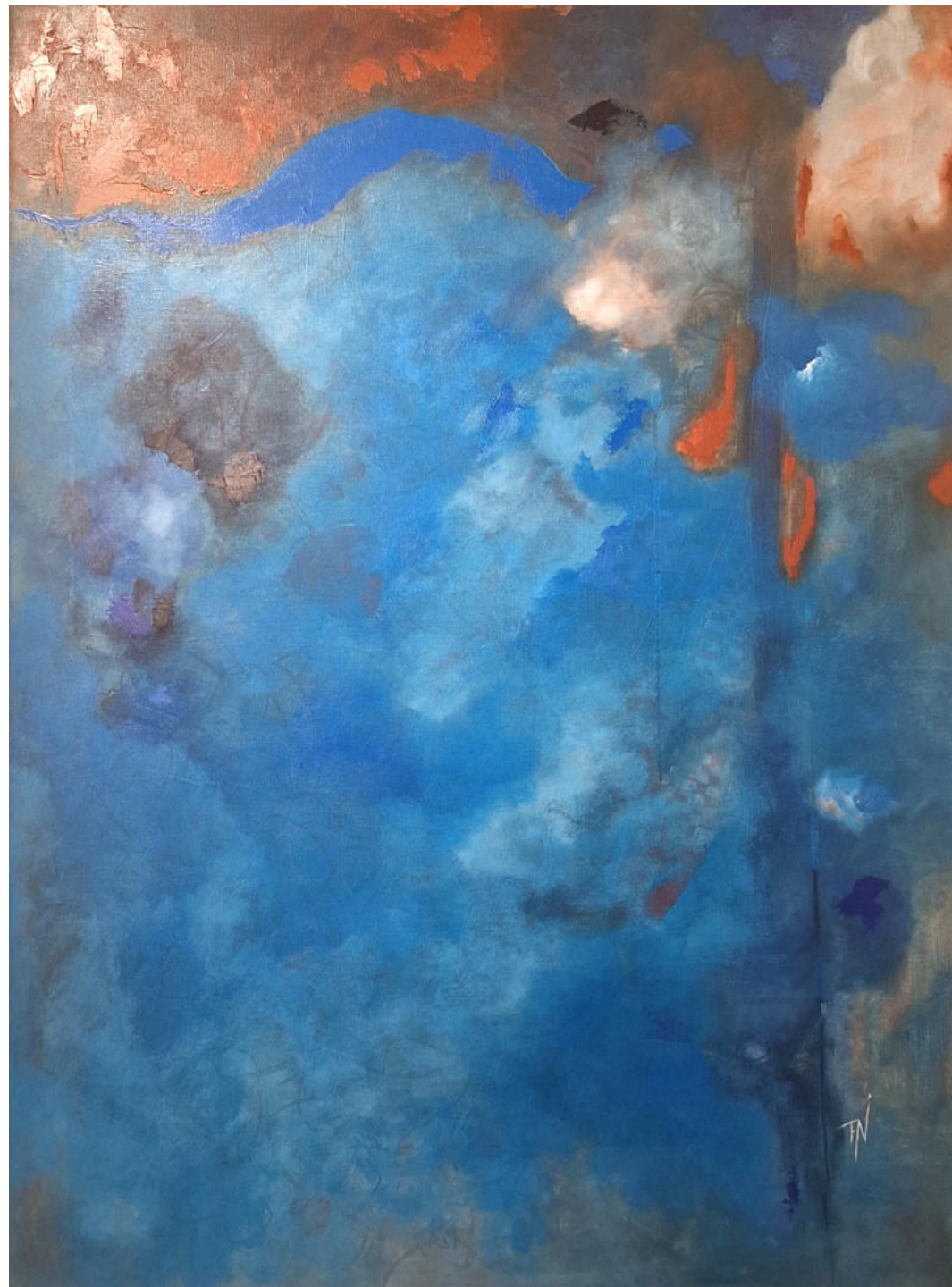

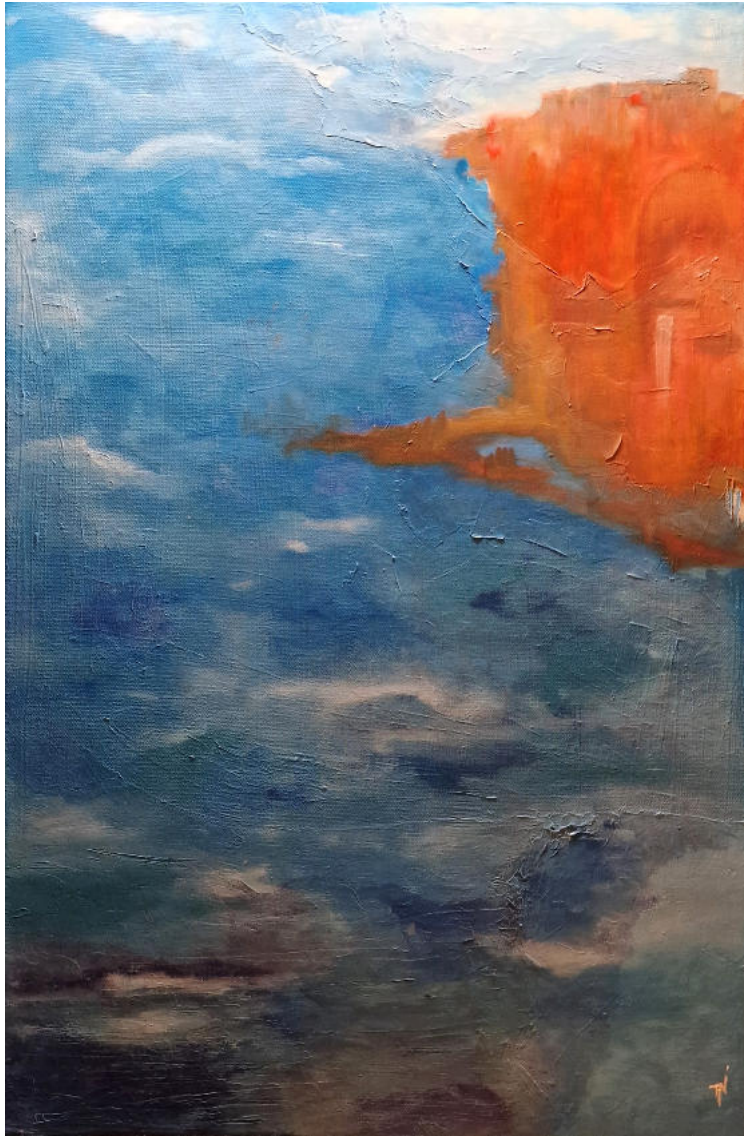

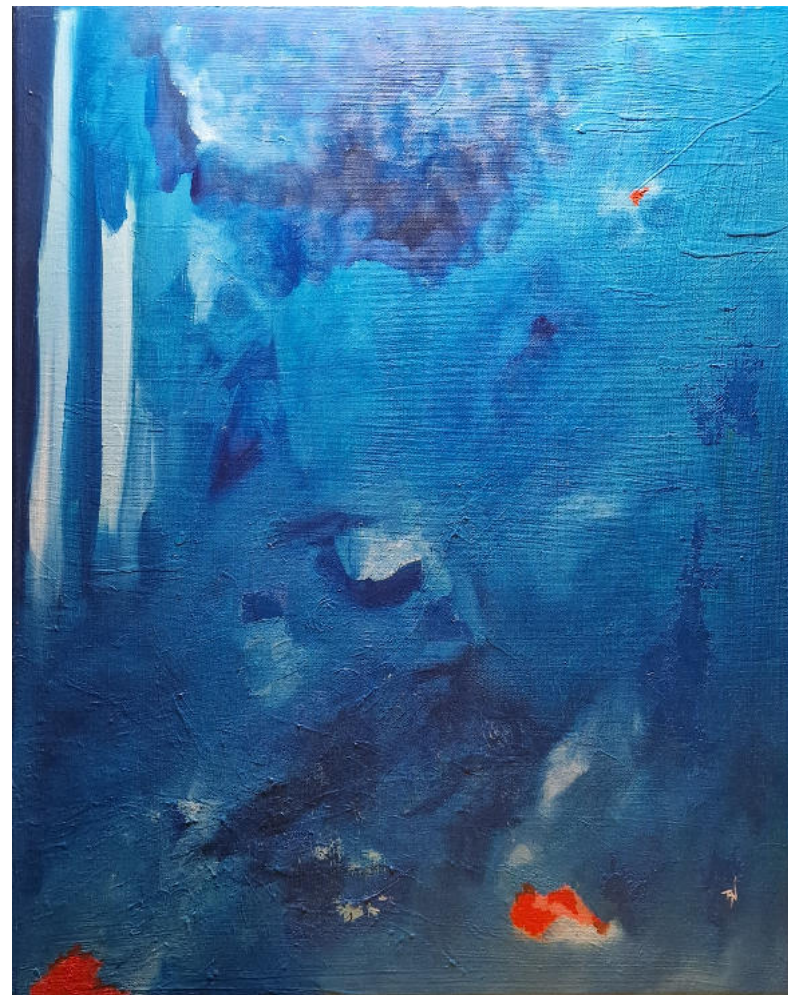

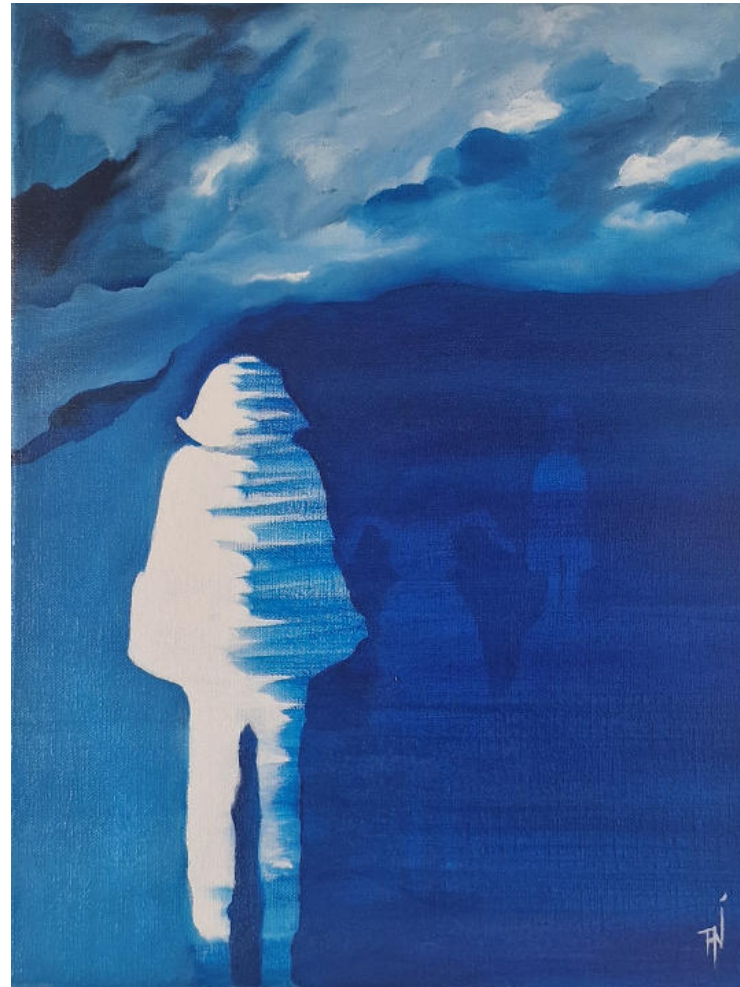

**Tani Telas**, pseudonym for Stephanie Navarro, is a French artist of Spanish and French heritage. Her **academic background** includes a Master's degree in Hispanic Literature, Languages, and Arts (University of Toulouse, 2011). Passionate about art since childhood (earning Special Mentions in Plastic Arts during her schooling), she refined her technique from 2022 to 2023 at the workshops of painter Jorel Sergio in Corsica, where she is based.

The year 2025 marks a major turning point in her international recognition, solidified by receiving the **Certificate of Artistic Merit from the Luxembourg Art Prize (La Pinacothèque)**. This distinction crowns a career highlighted by several honors, including three Honorable Mention Awards from TERAVARNAART GALLERY.

Her art is supported by an intense activity of **solo and collective exhibitions since 2018** (notably in Corsica and the Var region). The year 2025 is punctuated by a major series of solo exhibitions titled "Femme Med': Ancrage en Méditerranée" (Mediterranean Woman: Anchor in the Mediterranean), with stops planned in Le Castellet, Six-Fours Le Brusq, and La Londe-les-Maures on the French Riviera (Côte d'Azur).



*Tani Telas's work is a **manifesto of progressive abstraction** where the Mediterranean, her fundamental source of inspiration, is the vibrant heart of her expression.*

*An **active member** of several **art networks** (ACN, La Cour Des Miracles Compagnie), Tani Telas continues to enrich contemporary abstract art with a powerful body of work—a synthesis of emotion, instinct, and profound cultural rootedness. ■*
